### Points of interest in the Springfield MA Area

#### Springfield Armory National Historic Site

The Springfield Armory, located in the city of Springfield, Massachusetts, was the primary center for the manufacture of U.S. military firearms from 1777 until its closing in 1968. The site is preserved as the Springfield Armory National Historic Site, Western Massachusetts' only unit of the national park system. It features the world's largest collection of historic American firearms.

#### Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, located in Springfield, Massachusetts, United States, honors extraordinary basketball players, coaches, referees, executives, and other major contributors to the game of basketball worldwide.

#### Zoo In Forest Park

The Zoo In Forest Park is a zoo located in Springfield, Massachusetts, USA.

#### Six Flags New England

Six Flags is a 170-acre theme park that features over 130 rides, shows and attractions. Some of the highlights include the inverted looping "Mind Eraser" roller coaster, "Scream" and "Superman-Ride of Steel". There are specially designed areas for kids.

#### Volleyball Hall of Fame

The Volleyball Hall of Fame was founded to honor extraordinary players, coaches, officials, and leaders who have made significant contributions to the game of volleyball. The hall is located in Holyoke, Massachusetts, where volleyball was invented in 1895 by William G. Morgan at the local YMCA.
